

On motion by **Councilman Crosby** and seconded by **Councilman Miller**, the following action was discussed:

**A TEMPORARY MORATORIUM PROHIBITING
THE ISSUANCE OF “CLASS A” ALCOHOLIC
BEVERAGE LICENSES.**

It is moved that a 30-day moratorium be established prohibiting the issuance of new “Class A” (on any new locations for bars, lounges, night clubs whose primary sales are alcoholic beverages) alcohol licenses and that a study of the impact of new “Class A” alcohol licenses be performed by the City administration.

THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO ARTICLES 74-51 and by the City Council acting as legislative authority for the City of Gretna does hereby establish a 30-day moratorium prohibiting the issuance of new “Class A” (on any new locations for bars, lounges, night clubs whose primary sales are alcoholic beverages) alcohol licenses and that a study of the impact of new “Class A” alcohol licenses be performed by the administration.

Provided that a majority of the City Council has voted in favor of this moratorium, this moratorium shall have immediate full force and effect of law.

This moratorium having been submitted to a vote, the vote thereon was as follows:
