ORDINANCES INTRODUCED

The ordinances below were introduced at the January 13, 2016 and November 10, 2015 Council Regular meetings respectively. Said ordinances will be considered for adoption by the City Council of the City of Gretna at a Public Hearing on Wednesday, February 10, 2016 at 5:30 P.M., Mayor and Council Regular meeting at 740 Second Street, Gretna City Hall, 2nd Floor Council Chambers, Gretna, Louisiana.

A through D introduced at the January 13, 2016.

- A.** An ordinance adopting the Amended Budget for the City of Gretna, Louisiana for the Fiscal Year of April 1, 2015 to March 31, 2016.
- B.** An ordinance revoking the public dedication of the air space above the westerly sidewalk that abuts the adjacent property, also known as 307 Huey P. Long Avenue, and further described as Lot 11A, Square 10, Mechanickham Subdivision. The purpose of the assignment of rights is to allow occupants of the adjacent property to complete renovations and additions to the building situated on same. The additions will extend into the air space.
- C.** An ordinance approving the resubdivision of Lots 1, 2 and 3, Square 21, Garden Park Subdivision, Gretna, Louisiana **INTO** Lots 1-A, 2-A & 3-A, Square 21, Garden Park Subdivision, as per the plan of survey & resubdivision of Dufrene Surveying and Engineering Inc., dated December 16, 2015. **Vacant Lots (Westbank Expressway, Willow Dr. & 11th Street)**

- D.** An ordinance amending the Gretna Code of Ordinances, Chapter 102. Zoning and Subdivisions; more particularly amending Section 102-101. - Monroe Street Mixed Use Overlay District.

E and F, introduced November 10, 2015.

- E.** An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 1945 of the City of Gretna, adopted by the City Council on the 12th day of July 1989, more particularly amending the zoning classification of the area bounded to the north by McDonough Street, the east by Monroe Street, the south by Solon Street and the west by Monroe Street by changing the Zoning of all properties fronting on Monroe Street between Solon Street and McDonough Street to Monroe Street Mixed Use (MSMOD) and directing, authorizing and empowering the Code Enforcement Official to alter and amend the Official Zoning Map of the City of Gretna.
- F.** An ordinance adopting and enacting a new code for the City of Gretna, Louisiana; providing for the repeal of certain ordinances not included therein; and providing when such code and this ordinance shall become effective.
