

On motion by **Councilman Rau** and seconded by **Councilman Crosby** the following action was discussed:

**A 180-DAY MORATORIUM PROHIBITING THE  
ISSUANCE OF “CLASS A” ALCOHOL LICENSES IN  
THE CITY OF GRETNA, LOUISIANA.**

**It is moved that a 180-day moratorium be established prohibiting the issuance of new “Class A” (bars, lounges, night clubs and any other businesses whose primary sales are alcoholic beverages) alcohol licenses and that a study of the impact of new “Class A” alcohol licenses be performed by the administration.**

**THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO ARTICLES 74-51 and 74-52 and by the City Council acting as legislative authority for the City of Gretna does hereby establish a 180-day moratorium prohibiting the issuance of new “Class A” (bars, lounges, night clubs and any other businesses whose primary sales are alcoholic beverages) alcohol licenses in the City of Gretna, Louisiana; and that a study of the impact of new “Class A” alcohol licenses be performed by the administration.**

Provided that a majority of the City Council has voted in favor of this moratorium, this moratorium shall have immediate full force and effect of law.

This moratorium having been submitted to a vote, the vote thereon was as follows:
