INTRODUCTION OF ORDINANCES

The following ordinances were introduced at the October 11, 2017 Council Regular meeting and will be considered for adoption by the City Council of Gretna at a Public Hearing on **Wednesday, November 8, 2017 at 5:30 PM**, Mayor and Council Regular meeting at Gretna City Hall, 740 2nd Street, Gretna, LA 70053, Council Chambers - 2nd floor.

An ordinance amending the Gretna Code of Ordinances, Chapter 48. –Solid Waste; Article I- In General; more particularly amending Section 48-4.- Littering.

An ordinance amending the Gretna Code of Ordinances, Chapter 58. –Zoning and subdivisions; Article VIII. - Screening and Fencing; particularly amending Section 58-602 and Section 58-607.

An ordinance amending the Budget for the Fiscal Year of April 1, 2017 to March 31, 2018, to appropriate \$95,000 for the street signs project in District IV in the General Fund.

An ordinance setting the franchise fee to be paid by those entities providing cable or video service within the City of Gretna’s municipal limits under a state granted franchise authority and otherwise providing with respect thereto.

An ordinance amending, the Gretna Code of Ordinances Chapter 24. –Environment and Natural Resources by adding Sections 24-5 through 24-20; establishing the 25th Street Resilience District (bounded by the Westbank Expressway on the north; the Whitney Canal on the south; Belle Chasse Highway on the east and Heebe/Hero Canal on the west); and mandating strategic adaptations to respond to the District’s unique economic and environmental challenges.

An ordinance acknowledging a state of emergency declared by Jefferson Parish President Michael S. Yenni, in accordance with LA R.S. 29:272 and effecting the City of Gretna, authorizing a curfew and authorizing the expenditure of emergency related funds.

An ordinance providing for a “3-WAY STOP” sign to be installed at the intersection of 4th Street eastbound and Huey P. Long Avenue north; installation of said sign is contingent upon study results and approval by the State of Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development (LADOTD).

An ordinance approving the resubdivision of Lot 3 and Part of Lot 4, Square 20, Garden Park Subdivision, Gretna, Louisiana INTO Lots 3A and 3B, Square 20, Garden Park Subdivision, per the plan of survey and resubdivision of Dufrene Surveying & Engineering Inc., dated August 9, 2017.

An ordinance approving the resubdivision of Lots 3, 4 and Part of Lot 5, Square 15, Garden Park Subdivision, Gretna, Louisiana INTO Lots 3A, 4A and 5A, Square 15, Garden Park Subdivision, per the plan of survey and resubdivision of Dufrene Surveying & Engineering Inc., dated July 21, 2017.
