INTRODUCTION OF ORDINANCES

The following ordinances were introduced at the November 8, 2017 Council Regular meeting and will be considered for adoption by the City Council of Gretna at a Public Hearing on **Wednesday, December 13, 2017 at 5:30 PM**, at the Mayor and Council Regular meeting, Gretna City Hall, 740 2nd Street, Gretna, LA 70053, 2nd floor Council Chambers.

An ordinance setting the City of Gretna Legislative Calendar for the Year 2018, in accordance with the Gretna Code of Ordinances, Chapter 2. –Administration; Section 2-46. -Legislative Calendar.

An ordinance declaring vehicles, office and recreation equipment surplus property, and no longer needed for public purposes and to authorize the sale of said surplus property at a public auction. (3)

An ordinance repealing - Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance of the City of Gretna Code of Ordinances in its entirety and adopting a new Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance (FDPO) in order to comply with the requirements of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) and to provide for related matters. (Parishwide)

An ordinance amending the Gretna Code of Ordinances, Chapter 6.– Amusements and entertainments; particularly amending Section 6-5.- Gretna Heritage Festival; regulating sale of alcohol, by adding new language under paragraph (d).

An ordinance revoking the public dedication of the air space above the sidewalk that abuts the adjacent property, also known as 300 Huey P. Long Avenue, and further described as Lot 6, Square 9, Mechanickham Subdivision. The purpose of the assignment of rights is to allow owners of the property to complete renovations and additions to the building, which proposes upstairs balconies encroaching 3-inches into the City's air space.
