

Thinking of Installing a Permanent Home Generator?

Dear Resident and/or Contractor:

It is the responsibility of the City of Gretna to ensure not only your safety, but your neighbor's as well. We hope you find the following guidelines helpful when pursuing your wish to have a permanently installed generator within the City of Gretna. If you have any questions, please call the Building & Permits Office, at (504) 363-1563 and any member of our staff will be happy to assist you.

Checklist:

- A permit application must be completed online at www.mygovernmentonline.org or you may come to the Building & Permits Office, 740 2nd Street, Gretna City Hall, Room 101, to use the customer KIOSK.
- A plot plan of the property showing the placement of the generator with measurements from the property line and any structures will need to be uploaded with the online permit application. (No survey is required).

Please note:

- Distance from property line and any opening of other structures must be 5-feet or more.
- The exhaust from the generator cannot be within 5-feet of an opening, doors and windows.
- Some applications may require approval from civic associations.

• The Fire Board and/or Fire Department review is required with approval.

- Once you have completed all the above items, please upload them with your online permit application, or bring them to the Building & Permits Office, Gretna City Hall Room 101.
- A site inspection will be required to approve the proposed location of the generator. Once cleared with our inspector, then permit will be issued.
- The manufacturer's installation instructions will need to be made available for review.
- A generator must be anchored and placed on a stable foundation.
- A Gretna <u>licensed electrician</u> must file on the generator, and a Gretna <u>licensed plumber</u> must file on the gas meter. Both must be filed online <u>www.mygovernmentonline.org</u> using the Permit Project number.
- Licensed tradesmen <u>must</u> schedule their final inspections online <u>only</u>. If you have any questions, please call the Building & Permits Office at (504) 363-1563.
