DOTD Downtown Pedestrian Improvements Project March – July 2024



Public Meeting Monday March 4th at 5:30PM at the Gretna Cultural Center for the Arts, 740 4th Street

The State of Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development (DOTD) and its contractor Buck Town Contractors & Co. are beginning downtown pedestrian improvements including new sidewalks, crosswalks and traffic signals. This is a DOTD funded construction project to improve safety and access for pedestrians along 4th Street from Dolhonde Street to Huey P. Long Avenue, and on Huey P. Long Avenue from 4th to 5th Street.


Please see map on reverse side showing project area and note the tentative schedule and anticipated phasing of the project as follows:

- 4th St. construction duration: March through June 2024
- Huey P. Long Ave construction duration: June through July 2024

The construction team will be working as quickly as possible to minimize the disruption to Gretna neighbors and businesses. There may be some brief intersection closures at Derbigny and Dolhonde for excavation, new concrete panels, and new traffic signal installations. The City will notify neighbors in advance of any specific closures, and detour signs will be placed to reroute traffic.
